CAJE NEWS

The Evansville City Council will have a very important budget vote tomorrow, **October 8, at 5:30 p.m. Room 301 of the Civic Center.** The Mayor and the Department of DMD have committed \$500,000 from casino funds for the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. CAJE has advocated for funding for the trust fund to provide a source of loans to affordable housing developers and to provide assistance to those struggling to remain in their homes. With rising rents, Evansville needs approximately 5,000 affordable housing units to meet the demand. If you can attend the meeting, your presence will show City Council that Central UMC supports affordable housing – especially in our Church neighborhood where we see homeless individuals every day.
