The Boaz Prayer Ruth 2.10-16

7 April 2024

<u>The Lord repay your work, and a full reward be given you by the Lord God of Israel,</u> under whose wings you have come for refuge." **Ruth 2.12** 

- When faced with a need we reply, "I'll be thinking of you," or, "I'm praying for you."
- When tragedy strikes we respond with "thoughts and prayers."
- Our prayers are not even directional; "thoughts and prayer go out to..."
- Is it possible that by doing this we are actually dismissing legitimate concerns?

#### Context

Ruth was a childless widow from a foreign country.She was the sole means of support for herself and her mother-in-law.She worked essentially as a panhandler, or a gleaner.

1. Boaz prays for God \_\_\_\_\_\_. (thoughts and prayers) The Lord repay your work, and a full reward be given you by the Lord God of Israel, under whose wings you have come for refuge." **Ruth 2.12** 

2. Ruth asks Boaz if \_\_\_\_\_\_. And he said, "Who are you?" So she answered, "I am Ruth, your maidservant. Take your maidservant under your wing, for you are a close relative." **Ruth 3.9** 

> She was asking if he was willing to put his prayer into action. "Will you be the answer to your prayer?"

**Q-** What are the implications of this for our own prayers? For our own actions? **Take Away Prayer-**

I don't want to have a hollow faith, O Lord.

Fill me with your compassion for othersAnd inspire me to live a Christ-formed life.Empower me to make a difference in the world,And to live out my prayers. Amen.
