

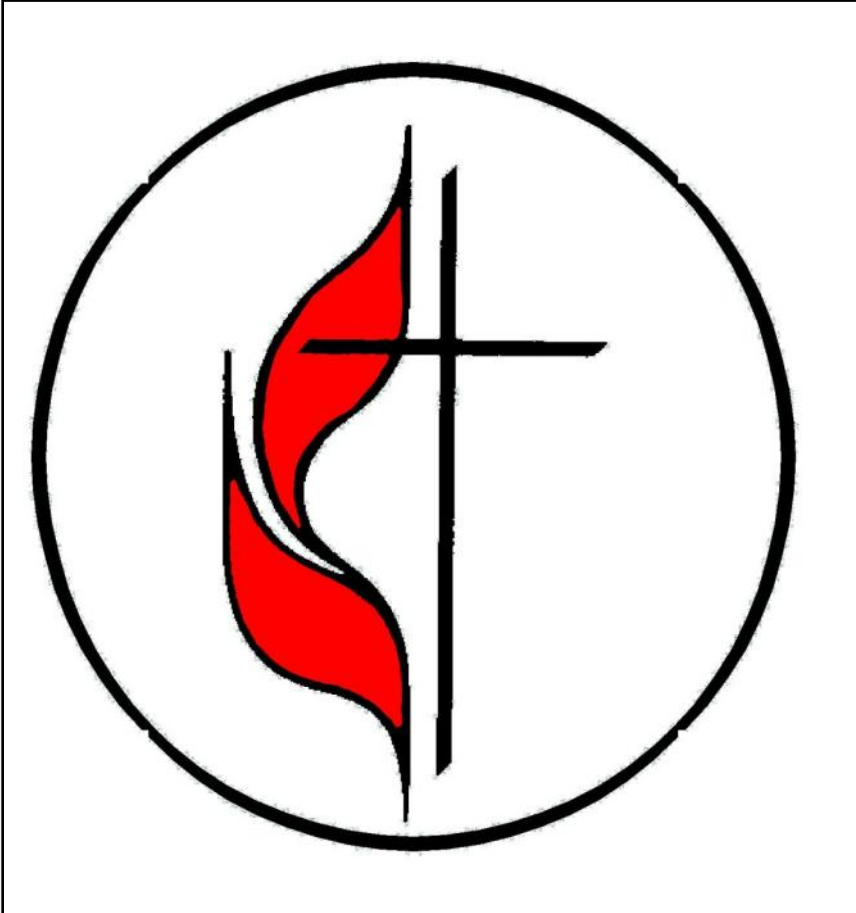

**Q-** What does it mean to call Jesus our “Lord and Savior?” When you hear someone use that phrase does it seem genuine?

**Lord-** ruler, one with authority; in the case of Jesus, he has authority because we give it to him.

**Savior-** one who saves; spiritually, Jesus redeems us from sin and offers atonement.

**Hypostatic Union-** Jesus has two natures, divine and human.

God from God/ Light from Light/ true God from true God

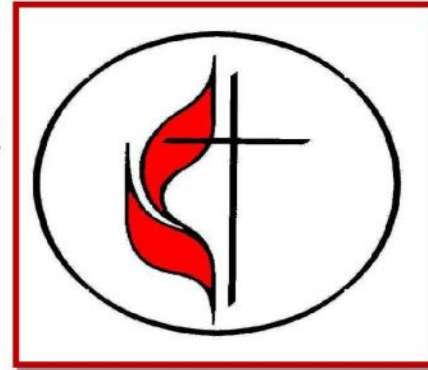
### Holy Communion-

- Memorial view- Bread and wine represent Jesus’ body and blood
- Spiritual view- We receive Jesus spiritually with the bread and wine
- Sacramental union view (consubstantiation)- Bread and wine do not become Jesus, but we receive him with them.
- Catholic view (transubstantiation)- Bread and wine are transformed into the body and blood of Jesus.
